

OATH OF OFFICE

A member of the board shall, before entering upon the duties of his/her office, take and subscribe an oath before the secretary of the board that he/she possesses the qualifications prescribed in Title 18A; 12-2.1, and the oath prescribed by Section 41: 1-3 of the revised statutes. The oath shall be filed with the secretary.

It shall be the responsibility of the board secretary to establish procedures to implement this policy.
