
Parliamentary Procedure

Unless otherwise provided in the school board by-laws, the Oxford Township Board of Education shall conduct its meetings in accord with the general principles associated with Robert's Rules of Order. A basic parliamentary procedure manual shall be provided to all board members by the school board secretary after the annual reorganization meeting*. When specific questions arise regarding the application of procedures, the President of the school board (or acting president) shall rule on the procedure that will be followed.
