

BUS CONDUCT RULES

These rules apply to ALL students riding on busses provided by the District – that includes all High School and Non-Public school students.

1. Students must only ride on the bus they are assigned to.
2. Only Oxford students living at bussing addresses are permitted on the bus.
3. Arrive at your bus stop at least 5 minutes prior to scheduled pick-up time.
4. Wait for the bus on the grass or the sidewalk (where available), not in the roadway or on any resident's private property.
5. Smoking, littering, spitting, profanity etc. are not permitted on the bus or at the bus stops.
6. Students must remain seated at all times, except when boarding and disembarking.
7. Seatbelts should be worn at all times while riding on the bus.
8. Backpacks, lunch boxes etc. are to be placed on the floor or on the student's lap, not on the seat.
9. Keep all parts of your body inside the bus at all times.
10. Objects should never be thrown or dropped from the bus.
11. Courtesy must be exhibited at all times to drivers, school officials, and other students.
12. Students must submit to the authority of the bus driver. If there is a dispute as to the authority of the bus driver, the student is to obey the bus driver and then report his/her concern to the school office.
13. Bus drivers have the authority to return the school bus to the school of origin or to bring the bus to the nearest police station in the event of a major disturbance on the bus.
14. Students and families are liable for all damages and costs. School records will not be released until restitution has been made.
15. Failure to follow the rules and any bus misconduct may result in the suspension of bus privileges and/or suspension from school.
