## OXFORD CENTRAL SCHOOL AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

This school year, we are instituting a new approach to some of our clubs. While there are some after school clubs that are fully-funded by the school district, we are not able to fund some of our newer clubs.

During the 2016-2017 school year, there will be an activity fee instituted for participation in the clubs listed in this brochure. The fee will be \$5.00 per hour for each after school club, per student. The clubs will run for a maximum of six (6) weeks. Some clubs may be held at another time during the school year for students in a different grade range.

Students may be asked to leave the club based on conduct that is detrimental to the efficient operation of

the club. Parents will be notified by the club advisor(s) prior to dismissal. If a student is removed from the club, there will be NO Refund.

All students in good academic standing will be eligible to enroll in an after school club.

The school district has made provisions to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to participate, no matter the financial status of the household during the school year. Parents who feel they might need assistance should contact Mr. Magnuson.
