Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day goes beyond just "shadowing" an adult. Exposing boys and girls to what a parent or mentor in their lives does during the work day is important. Showing them the value of their education, helping them to discover the possibilities of their future, and having a hands-on environment is key to achieving success.

Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day is organized during the school year so girls and boys can take what they learn in workplaces on Thursday and apply it to the classroom on Friday. By involving whole communities- schools, girls and boys, parents, workplaces, and mentors- the program helps young people make connections between what they learn in school and their future goals.

Some places of employment may not be appropriate for your child to spend the day (construction sites, waitressing, etc.). If you can't bring your child to work with you, what about sending them to work with an aunt or uncle, a grandparent, or a close family friend?

Also, if your child attends this special day with you they must obtain a note from your employer stating that they took part in Take Our Daughters and Sons to Work Day. This note should come to school with them when they return to school on Friday.
